Uniform:

Please send your child to school in full uniform every day so they are prepared for the activities they will take part in.

Our uniform is as follows:

Black shoes or trainers, white polo top or shirt, navy cardigan or jumper/sweatshirt (no logos except the school one), black or grey bottoms – skirt, trousers or joggers.

No jewellery except for stud earrings and a watch (not a smart watch)

Our PE days are as follows:

Mrs Robinson – Monday and Thursday

Mrs Hearn/Mrs Keim – Monday and Friday

Mrs Austin – Wednesday and Thursday

Children will need to come to school wearing their PE kit.

Our PE kit is a white T-shirt, blue or black shorts/ jogging bottoms, and plimsolls/ black trainers.

No **jewellery** or **earrings** are allowed to be worn during PE. We also ask that children with long hair tie it up in a bobble.



Maths Homework

We subscribe to a website called, **Times Table Rockstars**, which consists of various games to support the learning of their times tables, which is vital for success in maths.

Your child will have their login stuck at the front of their reading journal.

We ask that the children access this 3 times per week for 15 minutes at a time.



Reading

If your child is on Read Write Inc, they will bring home two reading books. One is a copy of the book they have read in school. The second book is linked to this, covering similar words and sounds. When children complete Read Write Inc. they move onto **Accelerated Reader**. This allows children to choose their own books based on their ready ability. The baseline assessment will take place in the next two weeks and children will then be able to choose a book to bring home.

Our expectation is that children should read their book at home
3 times a week.

When you've listened to your child read, **please comment or sign their reading diary** so we are aware that this has

happened. This information will be logged by their class teacher and celebrated in our Thursday assembly.

Reading books and diaries need to be in school **every day**. Please keep them in book bags so they are safe. Any lost or damaged books will need to be paid for at a cost of £5.

Spelling Homework

We subscribe to a website called, **Spelling Shed**, which consists of various games to support the learning of both their statutory year group spellings and spelling patterns.

Your child will have their login stuck at the front of their reading journal.

We ask that the children access this 3 times per week for 15 minutes at a time.

Behaviour
