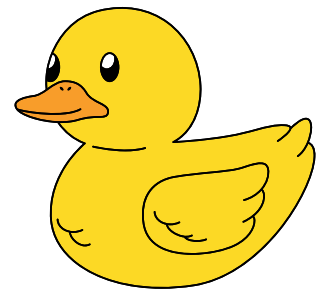

This term, we'll be focusing on helping the children settle into nursery life. We'll spend lots of time getting to know each other, building positive relationships with our teachers and new friends. Through a variety of fun circle time activities, we'll begin developing important skills such as sitting, listening, turn-taking, and sharing.

We'll enjoy exploring books together, including Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?, which will help us learn about colours. We'll also read the traditional tale The Three Little Pigs, where children can join in with the repeated phrases and enjoy retelling the story.

The children will have lots of opportunities to express themselves creatively, making marks and drawing freely using a range of materials such as paint, chunky chalks, crayons, and felt-tip pens.

As part of our learning about ourselves, we'll look at baby photos and talk about how we've grown and changed. We'll also begin exploring our five senses through hands-on activities and go on an autumn walk to observe the seasonal changes in the weather and our environment.

It's going to be a busy and exciting start to the year, full of learning, discovery, and fun!
